

## Amendment No. 2

TO THE GENERAL BY-LAW (BY-LAW NO. 1) OF THE ASSOCIATION OF REGISTERED GRAPHIC DESIGNERS OF ONTARIO (hereinafter called the "Association")

That section 3.03 PROVISIONAL RGD MEMBERS of the General By-Law be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

A A Provisional RGD Member is one who:

 has provided certified evidence of successfully completing a design-related, post-secondary diploma or degree program recognized by the Board, but has 8 or less years of professional graphic design experience

AND

(2) has completed an informal portfolio review (or other requirement as determined by the Board) to demonstrate a general ability to practice as a graphic designer and successfully complete the RGD Certification upon having accumulated the practical experience required.

B A Provisional RGD Member shall undertake to:

- (1) pass successfully all parts of the exam or examinations within one (1) year of fulfilling those qualifications.
- (2) A Provisional RGD Member shall fulfill these requirements or cease to be a Provisional RGD Member, effective at the end of The Association's fiscal year.

 A Provisional RGD Member may use the designation "Provisional RGD Member of the Association of Registered Graphic Designers" or Provisional RGD after his or her name, but may not use any modification of these statements.

(2) These designations shall be used only in direct connection with the name of the individual Provisional RGD Member."

This amendment to the General By-Law shall come into force without further formality upon its enactment.
